





Check contents

Separate all parts from the packaging and check each part with the "Pack contents" section.

Make sure all parts are accounted for before discarding any packaging material.

If any parts are missing, do not attempt to install your touch free soap dispenser until you obtain the missing parts.


Warnings

Do not install your electronic soap dispenser facing a mirror or any other electronic system operated by an infrared sensor.


In order to prevent reflection problems, it is recommended to keep a minimum distance of 1.50 meters between the soap dispenser and any other objects.

IMPORTANT: Keep in mind that the location of the user's hands, while using the faucet nearby should not interfere with the soap dispenser sensor detection area.




INCORRECT INSTALLATION

INSTALLATION

STEP 1 – REMOVE ALL MOUNTING HARDWARE


Drill a hole in the deck or lavatory for the soap dispenser body and a small hole for the anti rotation pin, according to the recommended hole size.

Disassemble the nut, disk and gasket from the base of the soap dispenser body.




STEP 2 - INSTALLING THE SOAP DISPENSER


Insert the soap dispenser body and the anti rotation pin along with the rosette into the holes drilled.



Under the deck, secure the gasket, disk and nut over the soap dispenser body nipple.


STEP 3 - CONNECTING THE POWER SOURCE





Connect the soap dispenser pump connector to its matching connector tor coming from the electronic unit.

Please note that since the connector is water proof, some friction might apply.



IMPORTANT: the 4 contacts connector should be connected properly so that the white o-ring is not visible and a clicking sound is heard.

PAY ATTENTION: If the 4 contacts connectors is not connected properly, the soap dispenser pump will work continuously.

Plug the transformer into the electricity socket and connect the transformer connector

Wait about 10 seconds before you place your hands within the sensor range.



FILLING THE SOAP TANK



SETTINGS ADJUSTMENT WITH A REMOTE CONTROL

If desired, use the remote control to adjust the soap dispenser settings. Hold the remote control straight in front of the sensor in a distance of about 4-6" (10-15cm).

ATTENTION: Holding the soap dispenser remote control out of the recommended range (too close or too far) may interfere with it's activation.

1-SOAP QUANTITY

Press the + sign at the SOAP button to increase the soap quantity by increasing the dispensing time and the – sign to decrease it.

Indication: continuous blinking of the blue light in the sensor eye.

2-AIR QUANTITY

To improve the soap "foamability" change the amount of the air to be mixed. Press the + sign at the AIR button to increase the air quantity and the - to decrease it.

Indication: 2 blinks of the blue light in the sensor eye.

3-RES

This function resets the sensor back to factory settings.

4-TEMPORARY OFF FUNCTION

This function temporary disable the dispenser and is ideal to perform any kind of activity in front of the sensor without operating the system (for example, cleaning). The soap dispenser will remain shut for one minute when this button is pressed once. To cancel this function and to return to normal operation press the On/Off button again or wait one minute.


5-FILL THE SOAP TANK

Once the soap tank has been filled \ re-filed, press the FILL button. The pump would work for one minute in order to fill the piping with soap.

To stop this activity press the FILL button again.

If the soap has not started coming out of the spout, press the FILL button again.

Indication: continuous blinking of the blue light in the sensor eye.

MAINTENANCE

Care and cleaning of chrome and special finishes

DO NOT use steel wool or cleansing agents containing alcohol, acid, abrasives, or the like. Use of any prohibited cleaning or maintenance products or substances could damage the surface of the soap dispenser. For surface cleaning use ONLY soap and water, then wipe dry with a clean cloth or towel. When cleaning bathroom tiles, the soap dispenser should be protected from any splattering of harsh cleansers.

Disassemble of the soap pipe from the pump

The soap pipe can be disconnected from the soap pump by a simple slide & pull action. The sliding ring of the quick connection fixation nipple on the pump should be pressed down. It releases the open end of the soap pipe which can then be easily pulled out.

Filter cleaning instructions

This soap dispenser is provided with a filter. It is recommended to clean the filter every six (6) months.

If the soap supply has decreased, this can be because the filter is clogged. The filter can be cleaned as following:

- 1. Unscrew the nut at the top of the foam compressor and pull out the filter.
- 2. Wash the filter under running water.
- 3. Reassemble the parts.

	Blue light in the sensor does not flash (once) when the user's hands are within the sensor's range.	Sensor is picking up reflections from the washbasin or another object.	Eliminate cause of reflection.
		Connectors between the electronic unit and power source are disconnected or not properly connected.	Connect the electronic unit connectors to the power source connector.
Foam is too diluted		Air ratio too low	Increase air ratio using the remote control. Refer to page 8.
